James "Jim" Fielder, 85, of Grand Island passed away on Wednesday, February 2, 2022 at Mary Lanning Healthcare in Hastings.

Jim was born on August 31, 1936 in Clarinda, IA, son of Mark and Doris (Campbell) Fielder.

His early school years were spent in Grand Island, where he made lifelong friends. Early into high school he moved with his family to Franklin. After learning all Franklin school had to teach him, it was common to see Jim doing odd jobs for the school staff. Jim graduated from Lincoln High School in 1955. Jim was enlisted in the National Guard for six years. Besides the weekend training he also assisted with tornado cleanup and other natural disasters. At a local dance he met Loretta Burton. On October 10, 1959 they were united in marriage and made their home in Grand Island. They were blessed with four children.

Jim used his mechanical knowledge and personable nature to excel in the sales department of NE Tractor and Equipment for 10 years. He was a farm

equipment salesman for Du-al manufacturing, Feterl Augers, and later as an Independent Representative for several other companies. He retired after 40 years.

Jim was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church. He enjoyed camping and fishing out on Sherman Lake, where they had a cabin for many years. Jim enjoyed golfing at Indian Head Golf Course. He also enjoyed solving the daily crossword puzzles in record time and his weekly games of shuffle board and KENO with his buddies at Tiffs Tavern in Doniphan. Even after being out of town for work all week, Jim always planned a project or two for the weekend. Jim loved listening and watching any sports. He had a voice that caught your attention and an infectious laugh, usually following a joke or well-placed sarcastic comment.

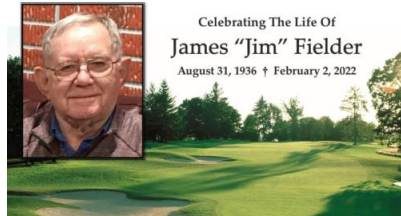

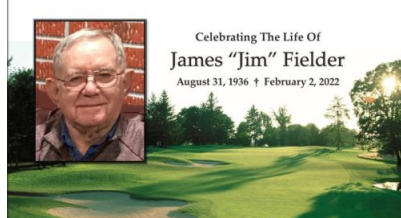
