Jeff "Gator" Gates, 65, of Grand Island passed away with his family by his side on Thursday, September 7, 2017 after a courageous battle with cancer.

Visitation and gathering of friends and family will be from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday at the United Congregational Church, 405 E. Bismark Rd., Grand Island.

Celebration of Life service will be on Tuesday at 11 a.m. at the United Congregational Church, 405 E. Bismark Rd., Grand Island. Pastor Lonnie Logan will officiate. Jeff was born on May 18, 1952 at Hastings, son of Byron R. and Mary Ellen (Alexander) Gates.

He is survived by his wife Gloria of 40 years; son, Chad W. Growing up he lived in Hastings, NE, Norton, KS, Wayne, NE and graduated from Central City High School in 1970. He was on the wrestling team for Central City and played Legion Baseball. His love of wrestling continued as he watched his son and grandson's careers of high school wrestling. He and Rod Shada spent many years going to the State Wrestling Tournaments. Jeff always looked forward to this men-only weekend.

After high school, he went to work at the Bonneville Plant in Aurora. In 1972, Jeff was drafted into the U.S. Army, he served during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged in 1974. He was then employed by Diers Motor Co, and later when it became Anderson Ford.

On April 16, 1977, he was united in marriage to Gloria (Dubberly) Shriner. With this marriage, he gained a step-son, Chad. The couple was blessed with another son, Ryan in 1978.

In 1994, he went to work at Southern Power District in the warehouse. Jeff retired in 2015. Jeff was always one to keep busy, he enjoyed wood working and could build anything. He loved the outdoors, Jeff's favorite place to go camping and spend a day or two on the water was Beaver Lake. Jeff and his family made the trip to Beaver Lake every year since 2005. His other love was traveling, to escape Nebraska winters and spend a week in the sun, Jeff would make the trip to Jamaica or Mexico. Jeff enjoyed traveling with family and traveling companions, Mike and Colleen.

Jeff was a quiet gentle man. Always kind and generous. If help was needed, Jeff was the first one to lend a hand or offer advice. Jeff was devoted to his family, and adored his grandkids.
