JoAnn Elgene Frickey, 84, of Grand Island, passed from this life on Wednesday, January 21, 2015 with her family at her side.

JoAnn was born August 19, 1930, on the family farm near Doniphan to John and Nancy (Stelk) Moeller.

She loved to watch football and was an avid Husker fan. She also enjoyed playing her accordion and in later years was a Fox News aficionado, with a knowledge of current events and politics. Devoted to her grandchildren and great-grandchildren, JoAnn loved spending time with them.
