John Henry Dahlke, 80, of Grand Island passed from this world on Friday, October 17, 2014 after a long battle with cancer.

Services will be 10 A.M. Tuesday at All Faiths Funeral Home with Reverend Lonnie Logan officiating. Burial will be in Grand Island City Cemetery.

Visitation will be from 5-7 P.M. Monday at the funeral home.

Born in Ulysses, NE, on September 11, 1934 to Norman and Selma (Krugman) Dahlke, John was baptized and confirmed in the Trinity Lutheran Church Missouri Synod of Grand Island.

John was a charter member and Assistant Chief of the Grand Island Rural Fire Department for 19 years; past president of Hall County school District 28;
