Jose A. Trejo, 74 formerly a member of the Grand Island Veterans Home died Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at the Central Nebraska Veterans Home in Kearney. To honor his wishes, cremation will take place with Graveside Services in the Omaha National Cemetery at 2 PM Thursday, May 27th. Military honors will be rendered by the United States Air Force and Millard American Legion. All Faiths Funeral Home is entrusted with the arrangements.

Jose was born November 8, 1946 at San Antonio, TX the son of Clemente and Victoria (Robles) Trejo. He was raised by his grandparents and received his education in Dilley, TX where he graduated from high school. On March 4, 1966 he entered the U.S. Air Force serving during the Vietnam War with duties as a combat support group in Okinawa. He was honorably discharged on May 2, 1970.

Following the military Jose worked as a shipping clerk and security guard. He made Omaha his home from 1966-2008.

Survivors include sons, Antonio Trejo of Carter Lake, IA, Jose Trejo Jr. of Omaha and David Trejo of Carter Lake, IA; grandchildren Clayton and Sara Trejo; brother, Clemente Jr. (Crystal) Trejo; sister, Annita Trejo Schantz both of Milwaukee, Wisconsin; niece, Natalie and nephew, Lucas. He is preceded in death by his mother, Victoria and his father and stepmom, Clemente Julia Trejo.
