“Joe” Joseph P. Aalborg, 74 of Giltner died Wednesday, February 4, 2015 at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha.

Mass of Christian burial will be 11 a.m. Monday at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church in Grand Island. Reverend Todd Philipsen will officiate. Burial will be in the St. Joseph’s Catholic Cemetery at Giltner with military honors rendered by the Aurora American Legion Post 42.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Sunday with a Christian Wake service at 7 p.m. at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

Mr. Aalborg was born July 28, 1940 at Clarion, IA the son of LeRoy and Wilma (Wanek) Aalborg.
