On June 26, 1960 she married the love of her life, LeRoy Hongsermeier. This union was blessed with daughters, Alison, Kimberly, Stacey and Jennifer. She loved her family dearly and was always there to help them.

Since Joyce grew up on the farm she was involved in 4-H. Through this association she learned sewing, cooking, and animal husbandry. She later used these talents while being a farm wife and taking care of her family. She was always trying new recipes and was an excellent cook. Her sewing knowledge later designed and produced wedding gowns for two of her girls. She ran the office at Ravenna Livestock salebarn for several years with her

husband. After her family was out of the house, she later worked for Nebraska Agricultural Statistics Service taking surveys and doing audits in corn and bean fields. She also worked at the Grand Island H&R Block office during tax season as a receptionist, with her daughter, for over 20 years greeting many client's year after year, with many clients enjoying her friendly face with their yearly task. She was a lifelong member of Zion Lutheran Church North-Shelton. One of the organizations she belonged to was Lutheran Women's Missionary League and held zone offices during her tenure. She also did family genealogy and put together the history for School District 52, 100-year history program. She loved her dog Sadie and her assortment of farm cats.
