Joyce J. Schultz, 87 of Grand Island died Monday, February 20, 2017 at CHI Health St. Francis.

Celebration of Life Service will be at 3 p.m. Friday at the First Presbyterian Church.

Reverend Caroline Price-Gibson will officiate. Private family Entombment of ashes will be in the church's columbarium.

There will be no visitation. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

Joyce was born March 5, 1929 at Grand Island the daughter of Vivian "V.M." and Clare (Planck) Johnson.

Following the birth of their fifth child, Joyce went back to school graduating from Mary Lanning School of Nursing in Hastings. She worked for St. Francis Medical Center, served as Director of Nursing for the Grand Island Veterans Home and then became credit manager for the family business, Spelts-Schultz Lumber Co.

She volunteered for St. Francis Medical Center having received the Honorary Lifetime Member Award; St. Francis Medical Center Foundation Board member; Lutheran Hospital Board; American Red Cross volunteer having received the Red Cross Volunteer of the Year Award; member of the PEO Sisterhood; Grand Island School of Business Board of Directors; Crisis Center Board of Directors; Hospice Volunteer; Bridge Club and Book Club. She has been a member of First Presbyterian Church since 1951 with many
