Kay has been active in the Elks Lodge in Grand Island helping and cooking many meals for them. She also enjoyed the Elks Camping Club. She spent many nights in the stands at the car races watching family and friends' race. She also enjoyed collecting bears and has quite the collection. Cooking and baking came natural to Kay. She hosted a lot of the family holiday gatherings, where of course everyone loved her bread. She loved to crochet

and made many, many baby and adult afghans. She also made several lap blankets for cancer patients.
