October 4, 1931 - December 1, 2017

Kay Krueger, 86, of Grand Island passed away on Friday, December 1, 2017.

Memorial services will be at 2 p.m. on Monday at All Faiths Funeral Home, with a gathering of friends and family the hour prior. Dan Naranjo will officiate. Military honors will be rendered by the U.S. Navy and Veteran's Honor Guard. To honor Kay, casual dress is requested.

Kay was born on October 4, 1931 in Grand Island, son of Rudy and Alma (Pokorny) Krueger; and graduated from Grand Island Senior High in 1949. He then attended Hastings College for a year and a half before entering the Navy in December of 1950. Kay served during the Korean War in the Aleutian Islands and in Hawaii, while working in communications and cryptology. He was honorably discharged on September 29, 1954.

While at one of the local dance halls, Kay met the love of his life, Vera Muhs. On August 12, 1956 they were married. Following their marriage, they made their home in Grand Island with their children.

As Kay had the ability to fix almost anything, he naturally assumed ownership of Krueger Radio & TV Repair when his father retired.

Kay was a member of the Isaac Walton League, GI Modelers Association, the American Legion, and the VFW. Kay felt it was important to give back to the

community and was a Boy Scout leader and a Hunter Safety educator. For many years he was a crossing guard for Westlawn Elementary, and spent three years as the conductor for the train at Stolley Park.

Kay enjoyed the outdoors and was a lifelong member of the NRA. Kay loved his family and shared his passion for the outdoors with them. Fishing and hunting season were family occasions.

Those left to cherish his memory are his wife, Vera; children, Dawn Lutz (Marvin) of St. Libory, Douglas Krueger (Cami) of Aurora, and Dana Kruger (Cindy Schroeder) of Burwell; brother, Rex Krueger (Karin) of Oregon; grandchildren, Justin, Kristal, Nathan, Ben, Morgan, and Jayke; and eight great grandchildren.

Kay was preceded in death by his parents and a grandson, William.

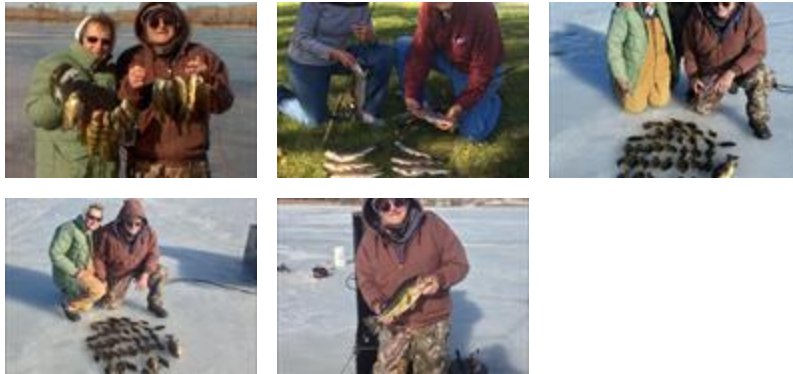
