Kenneth "Ken" Stuart DeJonge, 76, of Grand Island, NE, passed away on July 17, 2024, surrounded by his loving wife of 57 years and family by his side. Ken was born in Holdrege, NE, to Eiven and Ramona (Koch) DeJonge on June 27, 1948.

At age 14, his family moved from the farm to Hastings, NE, where he graduated high school in 1966. Days after graduating, Ken joined the Marine Corps and was stationed at Camp Pendleton, CA. On December 22, 1966, he married his high school sweetheart, Karen Dahl. He served in Okinawa, Japan, from 1967 through 1968.

In January 1971, he began his career at Northwestern Public Service in Grand Island, NE. His career moved him to North Platte, NE, in 1986, to become the Superintendent of NWPS. In 1997, his career took him back to Grand Island. After retiring, he and his wife settled on a farm in Wood River, NE, where he pursued his passion for raising cattle. He thoroughly enjoyed attending stock car races, golfing with his sons, and especially spending time with his family, while taking in Nebraska football games.
