Kenneth E. Kuck, age 97, of Grand Island, Nebraska passed away February 9, 2022 at CHI Health-St. Francis.

Kenneth was born in New Avon Township, Redwood County, Minnesota on December 19, 1924, and was the sixth child of George and Lilly (Garland) Kuck. He was raised and received his education in Minnesota where he lived until the age of 21 when he joined the U.S. Navy, serving from October of 1945 to September of 1949. On September 27, 1958 he was united in marriage to Betty Masnick in Lexington, Kentucky. They lived in Columbus, Ohio from 1959 to 1994. Kenneth worked in accounting for hotel businesses. He was preceded in death by his wife, Betty, in February 2000. On September 15, 2004, Kenneth married Carla Sander, the love of his life, and made Grand Island his new home.

Kenneth was a member of the American Legion and one of his more recent life highlights was the Honor Flight he and Carla were able to take to Washington, D.C. in 2012. Ken's daily routines included reading the morning newspaper as well as many books, especially historical nonfiction. Ken also enjoyed gardening, playing cribbage, and solving crosswords and world puzzles with Carla. Ken and Carla also enjoyed traveling throughout the United States.

Those left to cherish his memory include his wife, Carla Sander, her children, Michael L. (Penny) Sander of Omaha, Anita (Christ) Meyer of Friend, NE, Steve (Tina) Sander and David (Lori) Sander both of Grand Island, seven grandchildren and four great grandchildren, as well as numerous nieces and nephews and their children. He is preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Floyd, Glenn and Arthur; sisters, Mata, Birdora, Helen and Jeanne and his first wife, Betty.
