



## LaMae Emma Stoltenberg

LaMae Emma Stoltenberg, 91, of Grand Island passed away on July 12, 2024 at CHI Health- St. Francis. A funeral service will be held on Wednesday, July 17, 2024, at 11:00 am at St Pauls Lutheran Church, with Pastor Jeff Pedersen officiating. LaMae didn't retire until 2020 at the age of 88.
