Larry D. Cook, 78 of Grand Island died Monday, June 27, 2016 at the Grand Island Veterans Administration Hospital.

Celebration of life service will be 11 a.m. Thursday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Reverend Gene Arnold will officiate. Burial of ashes will be in the Grand Island Cemetery.

Larry was born June 28, 1937 at Borger, TX the son of Virgil and Beulah (Cartmill) Cook. He grew up in Amarillo and Big Springs, TX moving to Grand Island in 1952 and graduated from Grand Island Senior High class of 1956. After high school he worked at Sorenson's Body Shop, the Geer Company as a painter, moving to Colorado in 1959. While in Colorado he worked for General Iron, also owned Old Mill Auto Body in Littleton, CO. Larry enjoyed racing stock cars at Englewood Speedway for several years.

On July 28, 1970 he married Jan Bressler at Englewood, CO. The couple moved to Grand Island in 1973. Over the years they had several business's including, J&L Trucking, Larry's Automotive, Jan's Upholstery, and Fabulous 50's Gift Store. The couple restored many antique, classis, and street rods. They belonged to the National Street Rod Association and traveled to several states for rod runs. Larry retired in 1994 due to ill health. He served in the US

Army from 1954-1957 and was honorably discharged. He was a member of the Englewood Racing Association and National Street Rod Association. Survivors include his wife, Jan; two daughters, Jacqueline (Robert) Moersen of Garland, TX and Jennifer (Shane) Rassel of Sergeant Bluff, IA; three grandchildren, Trevor Moersen, Taylor Moersen and Julianne Rassel; three sisters, Jo (Beulah) Best of Tucson, Arizona, Sharon (Tom) Clemens of Grand Island and Carol Lee (Ben) Welch of Lincoln.

He is preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, Jerry Cook and Virgil Cook and sister, Viri Gene Waldrop.

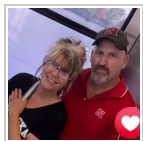

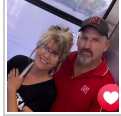
