Larry Wayne Gregg, 72, of Doniphan, died Thursday, March 27, 2014 at his home.

Celebration of life service will be 1:00 p.m. Monday at Rosedale United Methodist Church of Doniphan, four miles south of Doniphan and five miles west on Rosedale Road. Rev. Tom Lathen will officiate.

Visitation will be from 4-7 p.m. Sunday at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island.

Larry was born September 29, 1941, in Hastings to Lawrence and Clara (Hinrickus) Gregg.

Survivors include his wife, Karen; children, Tony (Jill) Gregg of Hastings, Bobby (Teresa) Gregg of Doniphan, Kristi (Mike) Peitzmeier of Yutan and BJ Gregg of Hastings; and sisters, Cheryl Mohler, Belva Randall and Janice Gauther.

Larry farmed south of Doniphan and drove a cattle truck most of his life. In his early days, he and his father followed the harvest crew. He was a salesman for Monarch Grain Bins and DeKalb Seed Corn.

During the late '60's, early 70's, Larry drove stock cars. Larry and Karen ran Nascar sanctioned Mid Continent Race Track for many years.

He was a avid antique tractor collector, and along with his son BJ, Larry was looking forward to the tractor drives this summer. He was building a trailer to enable his great grandson, Braxton, to ride along.

Larry loved watching his grandson Tyler play baseball and grandson, Jacob play basketball. He also loved going to the races every summer with his pals and throughout the year he watched all four children and his two grandsons race. Larry was so looking forward for Braxton to drive his go-cart. He enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren in their activities.

Larry was a member of the Rosedale United Methodist Church, the Saddle Club and was on the Rural Board of Directors for the Doniphan Fire Department.
