LeRoy F. Allen, Jr., 71 of Grand Island died Sunday, May 1, 2016 at his home. Mass of Christians Burial will be 10 a.m. Friday at St. Ann's Catholic Church at Doniphan. Burial will be in the Grand Island Cemetery with military honors rendered by the U.S. Marine Corp.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Thursday and an 8 p.m. Rosary, all at St. Ann's Catholic Church.
