



Lloyd Wesley Gloyne

October 16, 1950 - November 27, 2022

Lloyd Wesley Gloyne, 72, of Grand Island passed away on Sunday, November 27, 2022.

Rev. Dan Brenton will be officiating Lloyd's Celebration of Life Ceremony on Friday, December 2, 2022, at 11:00 a.m. at GI Free Church. Visitation with friends and family will be immediately before, starting at 10:00 a.m.

In keeping with Lloyd's wishes, his ashes will be interred at the Omaha National Cemetery. There, he will receive military honors from a United States Navy Honor Guard.

All Faiths Funeral Home is entrusted with the arrangements.

Lloyd was born on October 16, 1950, in Havre, MT, and grew up in nearby Lewistown, graduating from Fergus High School. He then attended and graduated technical school, and immediately following enlisted in the United States Navy.

Lloyd W. Gloyne served in the U.S. Navy starting August 3, 1971, until his honorable discharge on August 1, 1975. He was very proud to have served his country during the Vietnam War, and to have continued his service as a Seabee. Soon thereafter Lloyd used the G.I. Bill to enroll in college.

After attending and graduating from Montana State College, Lloyd left to help with the construction of the Calamus Dam in Burwell, NE. While working on the dam Lloyd became ill and was sent to the VA Hospital in Grand Island, NE.

It is at the VA Hospital where he met his nurse, future wife, and love of his life, Alice Lynn Schultz. On February 9, 1985, they were married at the Fullerton Presbyterian Church where Alice's father, Dr. Rev. Marvyn Roscoe Schultz, was the pastor.

Lloyd and Alice stayed in Grand Island where Lloyd would start his career as Quality Control Supervisor with Wilson Concrete, and retire as a specialist in calibration with Cal-Cert Co.

After meeting Alice, Lloyd Wesley Gloyne decided to devote his life to his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He was a proud member of The Gideons International, which gave him the opportunity to lead the weekly Hall County Corrections Bible Ministry for over 30 years. Lloyd and Alice are members of GI Free Church.

Among his favorite activities were being an ARRL ham radio operator "KI0MH", fishing, hunting, camping, leather tooling, and taking time for family and friends.

He is loved and missed by his wife, Alice; their son, Aaron; Aaron's wife, Sarah; their children, Elliott and Nadine; siblings, Rodney (LeAnna) Gloyne, Margaret (Tyrone) Meyers, and Stanley (Dolly) Gloyne; Alice's siblings, James (Susan) Schultz, Cindy Schultz, and Philip (Karen) Schultz.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Wesley Gray and Irene Elizabeth

Gloyne.
