Lola (Schwieger) Clark, 82 of rural Dannebrog, passed away early Wednesday Morning at CHI-Health St. Francis in Grand Island.

In 1979, Lola was united in marriage to Steve Clark, and the couple made their home in northern Hall Co, south of Dannebrog. They have lived on this same farm for 40 years.
