Lori G. Boughton, 59 of rural Grand Island suddenly passed away at her home on Saturday, May 13, 2017.

Services will be held at 10:30 AM Wednesday at St. Pauls Lutheran Church in Grand Island. Reverend Bill Pavuk will officiate. Burial will be at 2 p.m.

Wednesday in the Mt. Pleasant Cemetery southwest of Cairo.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Tuesday at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island. Memorials are suggested to the family with a fund to be established at a later date.

Lori was born March 23, 1958 in Grand Island to Robert R. and Donna (Schlund) Davidson. She attended Dodge Elementary School in Grand Island; school in Pueblo, Colorado; Centura High School and graduated from Grand Island Senior High class of 1976.

While in Colorado Lori developed a love for horses, cleaning stables, training and showing in 4-H events. She excelled in Pole Bending and Barrel Racing highlighted by competing at the famous Denver Stock Show. She won numerous ribbons and trophies with her Palomino, Pedro.

The family moved back to Nebraska due to her dad's failing health from cancer. She continued to stack up ribbons and trophies with Pedro under the guidance of Tommy Thompson. She shared her expertise with the youth in Hall County 4-H, including her daughter Nicole who also achieved an impressive collection of ribbons and trophies.

In high school, Lori worked at Dreisbach's, the South Locust Jack and Jill and

Brodkey's Jewelry and Lana's Imports after graduating. She also worked for Albee Printing and then Insurance and Personnel/Primark Inc. for James Green and Don Johnson. With Primark Inc. for 37 years she was the office manager for J.J. Green. She had also worked part time for Christopher Banks and Dress Barn. When the State Fair came to Grand Island Lori immediately signed up as an area supervisor. She brought smiles to hundreds of attendees with her helpful attitude and positive outlook on life.

United in marriage to Kent Boughton on November 25, 1978 the couple resided in Mitchell, S.D., Idaho Falls, Idaho and on two different farms southwest of Grand Island. She loved taking care of the yard, her flower garden and tomatoes. She loved Christmas and wished the season could have lasted year round with lights and decorations. Her family was the center of her world. She was like a second mom to countless young men and women in 4-H and friends of her children. Always a comforting force, she was there for everyone with a positive voice and assurance that everything will be OK. Her children, grandchildren and husband were especially spoiled as she would do anything for them.

Survivors include her husband, Kent; daughter, Nikki (Donavon) Anson of Grand Island; son, Chad (Jennifer) Boughton of rural Grand Island; grandchildren, Eli and Owen Anson and Avery Boughton; her siblings, Susan (Robert) Sandoval of Grand Island, Ric (Cindy) Downing of Orofino, Idaho and Michael (Norma Graves) Davidson of McLean, MD; sister and brother-in-law, Karen (Dave) Coker of Ashland and Craig (Leslie) Boughton of Springfield, MO and numerous beloved nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles and cousins. 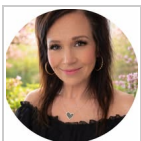

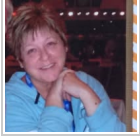
