Lorna Jean Dealey, 78, of Grand Island, passed away on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

Memorial service and celebration of Lorna's life will be held at 1:00 p.m. Saturday, December 4th at All Faiths Funeral Home. Daniel Naranjo will officiate. 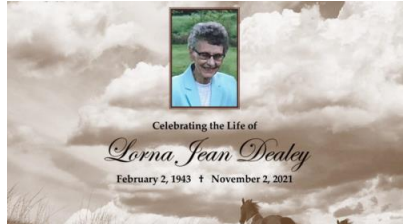
