Lorraine E. Schleichardt, 84, of Grand Island, died Wednesday, March 5, 2014 while visiting her daughter in Sebastian, Florida.

Services will be 10:30 a.m. Saturday, March 22, at All Faiths Funeral Home with Daniel Naranjo officiating. Inurnment will be in Grand Island City Cemetery.

A gathering of family and friends will be from 5-7 p.m. Friday at the funeral home.

Lorraine was born July 28, 1929, in Grand Island to Roy and Edith (Kammer) Westphal.

She leaves behind her children, Thomas (Kristin) Schleichardt and Cindy (Donald) Weddington; five grandchildren; four great grandchildren; sister-in-law, Lorraine Krecklow; a niece and a nephew.

Lorraine was preceded in death by her husband, Norman in 1998; daughter, Kay; her parents and brother-in-law Don.

She graduated from Grand Island Senior High School in 1946. Her first job was operator for Northwestern Bell Telephone Company. She was united in marriage November 10, 1949, to Norman Schleichardt and they made their home at the family homestead in Grand Island. They had three children: Kay, Thomas, and Cindy. Norman was a Union Pipefitter with the L.U. 464 and Lorraine was a homemaker. Together they enjoyed hunting, fishing and

traveling.

Lorraine loved fishing and caught a 350 lb Marlin while fishing in Mexico and in 2013, she won the Powder Puff Fishing Derby in Sheboygan, WI. She was also an avid horsewoman who led a local 4-H horse club for many years. Her most recent horse is a Palomino mare, Cinderella, who won a class at the 2011 World Championship Horse Show in Tulsa, OK.

Lorraine was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church, Platt Duetsche, Grand Island Saddle Club, Sheboygan Area Great Lakes Sports Fisherman Club, Ducks Unlimited, American Quarter Horse Association and Palomino Horse Breeders Association.

Her greatest joys later in life were fishing in Nebraska, Wisconsin, Florida and Mexico with her children, attending horse shows with her granddaughters, spoiling her great grandchildren and her two miniature dachshunds, and spending time with her many friends.
