Lyman E. Sigler, 85 of Grand Island died Sunday, April 26, 2015 at Wedgewood Care Center.

Mass of Christian Burial will be 10:30 a.m. Thursday at St. Mary's Cathedral in Grand Island. Burial will be in the Grand Island Cemetery.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Wednesday with a parish Rosary at 7 p.m. at All Faiths Funeral Home.

Mr. Sigler was born May 19, 1929 on a family farm near Litchfield the son of William and Beulah (Conrad) Sigler.

1975, Heron, SD from 1975-1985, Sioux Falls, SD from 1985-1992, returning to Grand Island. Lyman was employed as a buyer and general office manager for Nash Finch for 37 years.

Some of Lyman's memberships included the Knights of Columbus, Platt Duetsch and served as president of the Lions Club. He and his wife enjoyed woodworking, mostly having made Christian displays. Lyman made the manikins for the Crisis Center. He enjoyed gardening, particularly roses, mums and garlic. He loved feeding the lucky squirrels, rabbits and birds. Lyman was a proud man of his Christian Faith and family.
