Macyle Mae Shepherd, 79, of Garden City, KS, formerly of Grand Island, died Thursday, June 29, 2017 at St. Catherine Hospital in Garden City. She was born August 4, 1937 in Wood River, Nebraska the daughter of Robert and Merna (Mead) Wade.
