Manuel "Manny" Vega, 70, of Grand Island, passed away on Saturday, February 25, 2023.

Service and celebration of Manny's life will be held at 1:00 p.m. Friday at E-Free Church of Grand Island. Burial will be in Westlawn Memorial Park Cemetery.

There will be a visitation from 4-6 p.m. Thursday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Manny was born on July 27, 1952, in San Marcos, Texas, the son of Enrique Vega and Juanita Rodriguez. He lived in Texas until the age of 14, when he and his family moved to Grand Island. He attended school in Shelton and Grand Island. Manny entered the United States Army in 1972 and was honorably discharged in 1975. He was then in the National Guard for a year.
