Margaret Kuehner Hoeft, 92, of Grand Island Nebraska, passed away on Wednesday, May 12th in Grand Island. Margaret was born in Grand Island on February 6th, 1929 to Gottlob and Rosa Sundermeier Kuehner. She graduated from Grand Island Senior High School. While in school she was employed by the Grand and Capital theaters. Later she was employed by Northwestern Bell Telephone Co., and worked there for 14 years achieving the title of district plant supervisor.

On February 1st, 1958 she married John F. Hoeft of Grand Island, and they had been married for 63 years at the time of her death. To this marriage were born 2 sons, Brett and Jeff. Her family was the most important thing to her, and she loved everyone with her whole heart. The Hoeft's raised their family in Grand Island, and had several businesses. Margaret loved the Lord and was involved in teaching Sunday school, bible studies and prayer groups for many years, initially going to St Paul's Lutheran Church and later at Grand Island Evangelical Free Church. She and John raised the most money for the building of St Paul's Lutheran church in Grand Island.
