Margery Zamzow, 92, lifelong resident of Grand Island, died on Friday, May 3, 2019 in Lincoln.

Services will be Saturday, May 11, 2019 at 11 a.m. at St. Stephen's Episcopal Church of Grand Island. Celebrant will be Fr. Robert Lewis. Family will greet friends an hour prior. A native of St. Paul, Neb, Mrs. Zamzow was born June 13, 1926 to Charles and Mary Evelyn (Stewart) Kiechel.
