Marilyn B. Wiese, 84, of Doniphan died Sunday, February 26, 2017.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Wednesday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Service will be held 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Doniphan United Methodist Church. Burial will be in Cedarview Cemetery of Doniphan.

Marilyn was born January 9, 1933 in Doniphan to Clayton and Verna (Golgert) Robb. She grew up in Doniphan and graduated from Doniphan High School, class of 1950. In June of 1958 she married Leonard H. Wiese. The couple lived in Grand Island before relocating to Doniphan in 1965.

Marilyn was past Mayor of Doniphan and the editor of the Doniphan Herald for 14 years. She was a postal employee for more than 20 years, serving in Doniphan, Hastings and Grand Island, a job from which she retired.

A member of Doniphan United Methodist Church, Marilyn was also a member of the United Methodist Women and the Shepherd Group. She was an active member of the Doniphan Senior Center. Marilyn loved junking, antique collecting and garage sales. She especially loved spending time with her grandchildren.
