

## Marion R. "Bob" Hanna

Marion Robert "Bob" Hanna, 74, of Grand Island died on Friday, March 9, 2018.

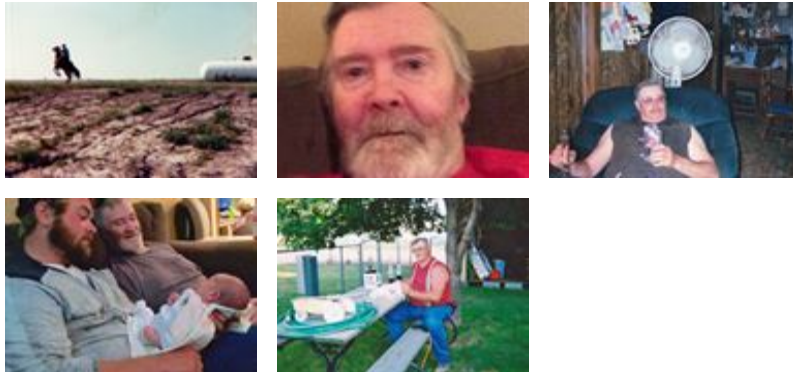
