Marion D. Omel, 95, of Cheyenne, WY, formerly of Grand Island, passed away on August 11, 2025. Visitation will be held on Monday, August 18th from 5-7 pm at All Faiths Funeral Home. Marion was born on August 24, 1929, in Giltner, NE to Armand and Alta (Lanterman) Omel. He was raised and received his education in the Giltner area. In high school, he was given the nickname 'Tuffy' due to his onery personality which he continued to live up to throughout his entire life. . After graduating from high school, Marion enlisted in the United States Army in June of 1951, where he proudly served his country until his honorable discharge in December of 1953 from Camp Carson, Colorado.

On March 4, 1956, Marion was united in marriage to Delores Meyer at St. John's Lutheran Church in Palmer. In their 66 years of marriage, they drove thousands of miles, traveled to 48 states, and went on five cruises. When they headed out for a Sunday drive, you never knew where they would end up.
