Marlene Roush, 83 of Grand Island died Friday, March 7, 2014 at Wedgewood Care Center.

Marlene was born January 4, 1931 at Grand Island the daughter of Dr. George and Edna (Nielsen) Leschinsky.

Survivors include her son, Michael D. Roush and daughter and son-in-law, Dana and Ron Jelinek.

She is preceded in death by her husband and parents.

Marlene graduated from Grand Island Senior High, class of 1948. She attended Midland College and graduated in 1952 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration. She taught at high schools in Wood River, Wolbach and Boelus.

She and Donald Roush where united in marriage in 1956. They moved to

California where Don was stationed at the Marine Base at Twenty Nine Palms. They were then transferred to San Diego for a short time before Don being deployed overseas. At that time Marlene returned to Grand Island. Following Don's military duty they made their home in Grand Island. Don passed away in 2000.

In 1959, Marlene began working in the Racing Office at Fonner Park. She worked there for 30 years. In 1979, she accepted the position of Registrar for the Nebraska Thoroughbred Breeders Association while still working in the Racing Office for ten more years. She then left the Racing Office to devote her full time to the Nebraska Thoroughbred Breeders Association. She remained in that position until 2011 retiring after 52 years of service.

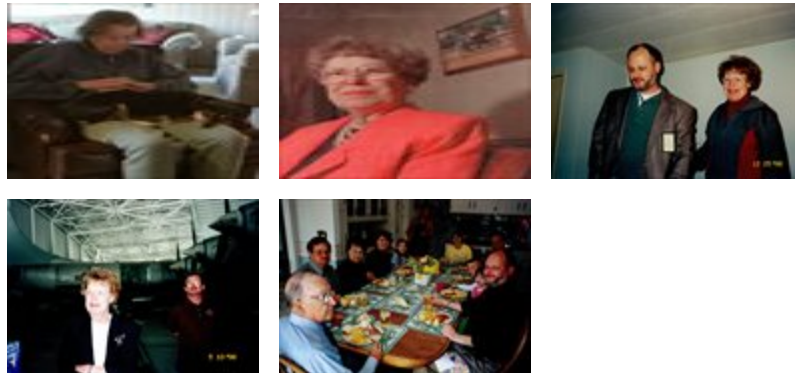
