



## Marnell "Marty" L. Van Hoosen

June 18, 1940 - August 28, 2025

Marnell "Marty" L. Van Hoosen, 85, of Grand Island, passed away peacefully on Thursday, August 28, 2025, surrounded by her loving family at CHI St. Francis Hospital.

Services will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 3, at All Faiths Funeral Home, with Dan Naranjo officiating. Burial will follow at Westlawn Memorial Park Cemetery. Visitation will be Tuesday, September 2, from 5 to 7 p.m. at All Faiths Funeral Home.
