Mary E. Fritzler, 54 of Doniphan passed away on Sunday, April 16, 2017 at University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha.

Visitation will be held from 5 to 7 on Tuesday at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church with Rosary to be recited at 7 p.m.
