



## Melvin LaRue Miner

Melvin LaRue Miner, 91, of Grand Island formerly of McCook, passed away on Saturday, July 14, 2018.

To honor Melvin's wishes, cremation has taken place and there are no services at this time. His ashes will be buried in the Wilsonville Cemetery at a later date.

Melvin was born April 15, 1927 in Furnace County, Nebraska, the son of Cecil and Mary (Stitzel) Miner. He attended school in Red Willow County.
