Micheal "Mike" Jason Morledge, age 74, of Grand Island, passed away March 23, 2024 at St. Francis Skilled Care surrounded by his loving family.

He grew up in Grand Island and attended Stolley Park Elementary School, Walnut Middle School and graduated from Grand Island Senior High in 1968. He was united in marriage to Ellen Olsen on December 27, 1973. They made Grand Island their home, raising two children Jason and Ashley.

Micheal was the owner and Chairman of the Board of Credit Management Services, Inc. Mike's leadership was the cornerstone of Credit Management Services, laying a foundation for stability, longevity, success and unparalleled growth. His commitment to innovation and corporate responsibility shaped a legacy that will be carried forward by his children Jason and Ashley Morledge.
