



## Micheal "Mike" Phillips

Micheal "Mike" Robert Phillips, 75, of Grand Island passed away on Thursday, December 18, 2024.

He and Carol spent many happy times going to wineries, bicycling, and enjoying time together with family and friends. In the last couple of years, Mike became an avid puzzle enthusiast.
