“Kenny” Milton Kenneth Brandt, 84 of Grand Island died Saturday, November 15, 2014 at CHI Health-St. Francis.

Services will be 11 a.m. Wednesday at Trinity United Methodist Church. Reverend Dr. Teresa Mason, Reverend Darren Guthridge and Dan Naranjo will officiate. Military honors will be rendered by the United Veterans Honor Guard and the Nebraska Army National Guard at the church.

Mr. Brandt was born January 8, 1930 at Albion, NE the son of Jacob “Fred” and Tillie Irene (Barbee) Brandt.

On June 1, 1952, Kenny was united in marriage to the love of his life, Helen Reynoldson at Albion. They made Grand Island their home where they raised their five children.

Some of his memberships included Trinity United Methodist Church, serving on many of the church's committees; Methodist Men; Stephen's Ministry; the American Legion Post #53; 40 and 8; life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars having served as commander; Nebraska Admirals; Korean War Veterans; Nebraska Army National Guard and Military Retirees; lifetime member of the DAV; United Veterans Honor Guard; Veterans Service Office Board and was a bingo caller at the United Veterans Club. Most recently Kenny was an honorary co-chair for the Korean War Hero Flights. He had a great love for Country, Flag, Family and Faith.
