



## Monty Roger Kyhn

January 2, 1937 - May 25, 2017

Monty R. Kyhn, 80, of Grand Island died on Thursday, May 25, 2017, with his family at his side.

Memorial service and celebration of Monty's life will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Burial of ashes will be in Grand Island City Cemetery with military honors provided by the United States Army and the Grand Island Veterans' Honor Guard.

A gathering of friends and family will be from 5-7 p.m. Thursday at the funeral home.

Monty was born January 2, 1937 in Cotesfield to Walter and Ruby (Gardner) Kyhn. He grew up in Cotesfield and graduated from Scotia High School, class of 1954. He was united in marriage to Kathryn Szwaneck June 16, 1956.

Following their marriage, the couple made their home and raised their family in Grand Island. He was a mason and bricklayer by trade.

On October 13, 1960, Monty entered the United States Army, spending time in Germany, and was honorably discharged October 9, 1962. He was a member of St. Leo's Catholic Church.

Monty enjoyed playing golf with the "Senior League" at Indianhead Golf Club, Nascar and Sprint car racing. He was also a fan of Polka music, especially the Chelewski Brothers. A wonderful husband, father and grandfather, Monty was proud of his family, especially his granddaughters.
