Visitation will be from 5 to 7 p.m. Wednesday at Third City Christian Church. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

Nicholas was born Dec. 10, 1999, at Grand Island.

Through his amazing faith he could overcome any obstacle that came his way including living with Tourette's syndrome. Nick will always be remembered by his big smile.

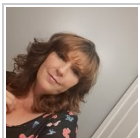

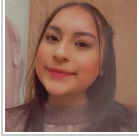
