in 1983. She
worked for many years at Trinity Lutheran School as a custodian's helper.
Over the years Paula enjoyed participating in Special Olympic bowling and
basketball. She
attended summer camp at Camp Luther and enjoyed learning about Jesus
with her classmates
in her C-Champs Sunday School class. At Good Samaritan, Paula continued
to write Bible
verses and sports' scores, read devotions, do beadwork and color. She liked
to play Bingo, and
walk the halls or outside in nice weather. She helped clean tables and open
and shut the blinds.
She had a delightful belly laugh and could be very silly.
She moved with her parents to Good Samaritan Independent Living in 2012.
She enjoyed
worshiping on Saturday evenings and would sometimes sing "Jesus Loves
Me" at the end of the
service. After her father died in 2016, she continued to live with her mother in
Assisted Living at
Good Samaritan. Her mother passed away in March, 2020, and Paula
continued to live in
Assisted Living until she moved to Skilled Care at the beginning of 2022.

(Sheena) of Amarillo, TX,
Stan (Laura) of Lincoln, NE, her sisters, Mary (Karl) of Papillion, NE, and Ruth
