Phyllis Leone Lepant, 89, of Grand Island, died on Tuesday, July 12, 2016 at the Grand Island Veterans Home.

She taught in the rural schools of West Happy Hollow and King School in Custer County, Broken Bow Public Schools, Sts. Peter and Paul School at St. Paul, Blessed Sacrament in Grand Island, and District 15 rural school at Hastings. Always staying busy, Phyllis also enjoyed quilting, embroidery, reading and canning.
