Robert "Dale" Harvey, 81, of Grand Island died on Wednesday, November 25, 2015 at Golden Living Center-Parkplace.

Dale was born on August 2, 1934 in Bloomsburg, Penn., son of Lester and Eda (Fox) Harvey.
