Randal "Randy" Sigler, 64, of Hastings passed away on Tuesday, August 22, 2017 at Mary Lanning Medical Center.

Mass of Christian burial will be held on Friday at 10 a.m. at St. Mary's Cathedral in Grand Island. Fr. Scott Harter will officiate. Cremation is to follow with a burial of ashes Saturday at 11:00.

Visitation will be from 4 to 7 on Thursday at All Faiths Funeral Home with a rosary at 7pm.
