



Randall Harlow

March 26, 1960 - January 26, 2015

Randall (Randy) Harlow, 54 of Grand Island died after a long drawn out battle with depression on Monday, January 26, 2015.

Services will be 10:30 a.m. Friday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Reverend Matthew Fowler will officiate. Burial will be in the Grand Island Cemetery.

Visitation will be from 4-7 p.m. Thursday at All Faiths Funeral Home.

Randy was born March 26, 1960 in Central City, NE moving to Grand Island in 1964. He attended A.B. Newell Elementary; was a proud Walnut Wildcat “Go Walnut, beat Barr”; and graduated from Grand Island Senior High in 1978. His crowning achievement was playing defensive end for the Islanders. He worked at Bill Baasch Welding throughout his junior and senior high years learning his trade as a welder. He went on to work for Wilson Trailer Company for eleven years welding and repairing semi-trailers. During this time he also bartended at the Brick Bar. In 1996 he went to work for Monfort as a slaughter maintenance mechanic. He has stayed with JBS until his death, serving in various management positions the last as a wastewater supervisor.

Randy was a member of the Platt-Duetsch; the IYACC Club and was a Turtle. Survivors of the immediate family include his parents, Harold (Dick) and Leola Harlow of Grand Island; his sister, Sherri and Joe McCormick and nephews, Kyle and Alex of Grand Island; his brother, Nick and Marie Harlow and nieces, Dylan and Sydney of Omaha; his sister Jean Harlow and niece Rachael of St. Paul; his sister Donna Harlow and nieces, Machala and Haylee of St. Paul; his sister Barb McCain and nephew, Aaron and niece, Andrea of Martel and

niece, Jennifer Wetzel of Grand Island.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents and his niece Stephanie Wetzel.
