



## Richard "Dick" Kool, Jr.

October 3, 1942 - July 6, 2023

Richard "Dick" Kool, Jr. 80 of Grand Island, died Thursday, July 6, 2023 with his loving family by his side.

He attended the Grand Island School of Business in 1962. Richard served in the U.S. Air Force from 1963-1967, serving in the Philippines, Greece and Vietnam.

On August 31, 1968 he was united in marriage to BonnieJean Kuehler. They made their home in Grand Island where Richard was employed by New Holland for over 30 years. Following his retirement, he worked for the G.I. Public Schools on the grounds, Northwest High School delivering meals, as a

bus driver for Hall County Transportation and Primrose Retirement. His memberships included Resurrection Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, the Izaak Walton League and American Legion. He coached Northwest Little League Baseball, and served as Cub Master for Pack 147. His heart was filled when he could attend a grandkids band, sport, school activity, or winning in a game of cards.

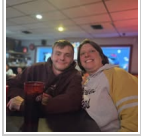
