Richard E. Kraft, 76, of Grand Island, died on Saturday, February 26, 2022, at his home after a courageous battle with cancer.

Memorial service and celebration of Richard's life will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Daniel Naranjo will officiate. Burial of ashes will be in Grand Island City Cemetery with military honors provided by the U.S. Army and Grand Island Honor Guard.

Richard was born in Greeley County, NE, on April 10, 1945, the son of Phillip and Grace (Fisher) Kraft. His early childhood started on the farm. The family eventually settled in Grand Island, where he received his education.
