



## Richard "Rich" Lehn

December 6, 1946 - December 10, 2023

Richard W. Lehn, 77, of St. Libory passed away on Sunday, December 10, 2023 surrounded by his family.

Richard was born on December 6, 1946 at the clinic in Loup City, son of Darrel and Julia (Einspahr) Lehn. The Lehn's were sharecroppers, who did everything they could to support a growing family; while Darrel worked as a mechanic and handyman in town, Rich and the boys took care of farms near Long Pine, Rose, Davis Creek, North Loup, and Arcadia before the family finally settled in Boelus.

Richard graduated from Arcadia where he was an excellent football player, fans recall during games his mother could be found on the sidelines shouting for number 80.

Richard moved to Lincoln to work at the downtown Walgreens. He met his first wife, Bernadette Skibinski and the marriage was blessed with two children, Chris and Tonia.

Richard was employed at Swift, and later alongside his father at the Army Ammunitions plant in Grand Island after his divorce.

Grand Island is where he met the love of his life and best friend Mary Wood, they were married at the courthouse on April 22, 1975, and they were blessed

again, this time with their only child, a daughter, Mandy.

Richard worked at the Chief Industries maintenance department while living in Boelus, during this time, Rich and Mary loved taking their family, Chris, Tonia, and Mandy, along with family friend Dave Miller, on long drives in the Sandhills, listening to the oldies radio station, or for many camping, fishing, and canoe trips on the Loup River.

Richard and Mary lost their beloved daughter, Mandy in a fire which took away the main-street store-front house in Boelus in 1989. After slowly picking up the pieces, they moved to the country near the unincorporated town of Worms.

During this time Rich and Mary both worked at Island Landhandlers until their retirement. They enjoyed the peace of the outdoors, and loved sharing this little corner of nature by Worms. This home became a favorite gathering place for holidays with family over the years, many stray cats and dogs, and once even a goat, found a home with them, they loved gardening, and he enjoyed warming their home with his wood stove, or sitting around the firepit with family and friends.

Richard and Mary found a strong community of friends at the Bunkhouse and also Fly's Bar, they were big Husker Football and Volleyball fans, but were particularly devoted to NASCAR, all friends and family knew not to interrupt a race, when a family event conflicted with a race, Richard would bring along a portable T.V. to catch both events.

After Mary's passing in 2019, Richard started bringing his German Short-Haired Pointer, Smoke, on the daily drives to Shady Bend Café for lunch. His quiet resilience and steadfast love for his family and friends will be missed. His memory is cherished by his son, Chris (Melissa) Lehn and children, Derek and Jacob; daughter, Tonia Smith and children, Dustin (Kaitlin) Smith, great grandson, JJ, and Cassandra Smith, son-in-law, Alan Smith, brother, Curt (Debbie) Lehn of Alda; sister, Connie of La Vista; mother of his children, Bernadette Lehn of Papillion; numerous nieces, nephews and extended family and friends.
