Robert "Bob" Cashoili, 69, of Hansen passed away on Thursday, December 10, 2020 at CHI-Health St. Francis.

Bob was born on January 21, 1951 in Hammond, IN. He was the eldest child and only son of Robert J. and Marguerite (May) Cashoili, Sr.

Bob graduated from Lewis Central High School in Council Bluffs in 1969. He was an All-State Athlete throughout high school in both football and wrestling. He went on to earn his Juris Doctorate from UNL in 1981, and began his own private practice in Eagle, NE. In 1987, Bob moved his family to the tri-city area and began his work as a Deputy Hall County Attorney. During that time, he worked cases that centered on the health and safety of children in the area. He became a humble protector to those who needed him most. He was a long-standing board member of the Child Advocacy Center. After his retirement in 2013, Bob continued to help those in need by volunteering at the Hall County Victim Assistance Program.

Bob became well-known for the hobbies he would indulge in during his free time. On the weekends, you could find him blasting classic rock while working on one of his many home-improvement projects. Every summer he would tend to his continuously growing vegetable and flower beds. He loved baking so much that his friends called him "Bobby Crocker." He was notorious for

playing intricate pranks on his children and coworkers throughout the years. Above all, Bob had a passion for a great bargain. He was a regular attendant at auctions and garage sales, and never bought anything at full price if he could help it.

As an unassuming presence, Bob has touched the lives of those around him in many ways. His compassion for others, his love for children, and his endless bounds of humor will reverberate forever in the lives of this community. Whatever Bob did, he did in a big way.

Bob is survived by his children, Nicholas (Anna) Cashoili of Ord, Mikel Cashoili of Omaha, Matthew (Brett Ballantyne) Cashoili of Omaha; father, Robert Cashoili Sr.; girlfriend, Kerry Garza of Grand Island; sisters, Elizabeth Cashoili, Kathy Zaloudek, Linda (Mike) Mitas, and Helen (Kirk) Snowdon; former wife and mother of their children, Jean Cashoili; along with numerous extended family and friends.
