Robert "Bob" James Crosby, age 68, of Grand Island, passed away on Monday, March 9, 2026, at home surrounded by his loving family.

Bob was born on August 19, 1957, in Huron, SD. He was born to Nancy Wallingford and at six months old adopted by James and Doris (Nieland) Crosby. Bob was raised in South Dakota until he was 16 years old and the family moved to Hastings. In 1974 he enlisted in the United States Navy and served until he was honorably discharged in 1978. While in the Navy he was a fireman on the USS Kitty Hawk.

He also liked playing his guitar, watching sprint car races and NASCAR. After retirement he found enjoyment in the quiet of nature, watching and feeding the birds and squirrels.
