



## Robert Edwin "Bob" Porter

March 30, 1946 - December 19, 2017

Robert Edwin "Bob" Porter, 71, passed away Tuesday, December 19, 2017 at the VA Hospital in Omaha, NE after a long, hard fought battle with cancer. To honor Bob's wishes, cremation has taken place and there will be no service at this time. A Celebration of life will take place at a later date. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

Bob was born March 30, 1946 in Des Moines, Iowa, the son of James and Wilma LaVon (Hawkins) Porter. He entered the United States Marines on January 30, 1964. Serving in Vietnam, Bob was honorably discharged January 29, 1968.

On July 19, 1987, Bob married his best friend, Karen Roepke. Together they made the most of life. Bob was an over the road truck driver for 44 years, traveling more than 6.5 million miles, some of which Karen drove with him. In Bob's words, he was a "roads scholar".

After Bob's retirement in 2014, they continued to travel. Vacations were usually in the North Woods of Minnesota or Wisconsin, but included the east coast and west coast as well. He was an avid bicyclist, loved to snowmobile and fish.

Bob impacted so many lives. He loved to tease and make people smile. His mission was to make anyone he came in contact with have a better day.
