Robert Charles "RC" Templin, 93, of Grand Island, died peacefully on Thursday, March 8th, 2018, at CHI-Health St. Francis, surrounded by family.

The Celebration of Life Service will be Wednesday, March 21, 2018, at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island. It will begin at 1:00 PM with a time of visiting, with Prayer Service at 2:00 PM, with a reception following. Daniel Naranjo will officiate.

Robert was born on September 1, 1924 to Charles and Opal (Wood) Templin in Stanton, NE. He graduated from Stanton High School and went on to serve in WW 2, Army Air Corp. After he returned home he was part owner of Baker's Sporting Goods, Fremont, NE, before he became a salesman for M0-Kan Chemical Company. After his retirement he went to work as a merchandiser for Kraft.

On December 31, 1969, Robert was united in marriage to Peggy Larson. They made Grand Island their home.

Robert was a member of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church, the American Legion, Heartland Shooting Park, and the oldest member, literally and figuratively, at the Health-Plex Fitness Center. He enjoyed boating, waterskiing, mowing his yard and easement, golfing, fishing, hunting- having

taken many hunting trips, anything out-of-doors, traveling and dancing with the love of his life – Peggy.
